- Our Curriculum

The curriculum at Farington Primary School is broad and balanced and is based upon the National Curriculum. The Reception class follows the Early Foundation Stage Curriculum Guidance.

The curriculum is delivered in an imaginative and stimulating way to encourage creativity and develop enthusiasm, providing children with a firm base of knowledge, skills and positive attitudes to learning.

Particular care is taken to ensure that, from the earliest days, children are treated as individuals and that work is carefully matched to their capabilities. The curriculum at Farington Primary School is geared to the individual needs and stages of development of each child. Teachers recognise that the foundations laid down by parents' forms the starting point for further progress, and that this progress is the shared responsibility of both parents and teachers.

Appropriate knowledge, concepts and skills are introduced at the correct developmental stage for each child in line with the National Curriculum. With lessons there is an effective blend of class, group or individual teaching, involving children in discussion, reasoning, experimenting and problem solving situations.

Structured play, both indoors and outdoors, is an essential part of the curriculum especially for younger children.

Enrichment

As a fundamental part of our commitment and vision to develop successful future citizens, our school curriculum is embedded with a number of enrichment opportunities for our children.

In Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 children will take part in various projects which complement their in class studies and develop key knowledge, life skills and social responsibilities. Children also take part in new
